

**INNOVATION MONTESSORI, INC.
POLICY ON CREDIT RECOVERY**

1. Policy. It is the intent of the Board of Directors (“Board”) of Innovation Montessori, Inc. (the “School”) to provide credit recovery opportunities for students attending Innovation Montessori High School that have fallen behind, subject to the restrictions set forth therein. Credit recovery may be offered through opportunities to retake the course at Innovation Montessori High School or online through Florida Virtual School. The Principal retains final decision-making authority with respect to the means of credit recovery.

All students attending Innovation Montessori High School will be entitled to three (3) cumulative credit recovery attempts during their entire time enrolled at the school. If a student fails to start a course or does not complete a course, it will count as one (1) of the three (3) total attempts. Students that are taking a credit recovery course for which there is a statewide assessment are required to participate in the statewide assessment aligned to the course.

Students who have used all three (3) credit recovery attempts will not be entitled to take any more credit recovery courses unless they are granted a good cause exemption by the Principal. The parent or guardian of a student who is out of credit recovery attempts may petition the Principal for a good cause exemption. The Principal, in his or her sole discretion, can choose whether or not to grant a good cause exemption, which decision is not appealable. A good cause exemption may be granted where the student is otherwise making satisfactory progress with current coursework and has demonstrated a sincere commitment to making up the necessary credits, or for other good cause shown.

The parent or guardian of a student who has exhausted all credit recovery attempts and who is not on track to meet the graduation requirements will be required to sign a written acknowledgement that they have been informed of the consequences of continued enrollment at Innovation Montessori High School.

2. Effective Date. This policy shall become effective with the start of the 2023-24 school year and shall remain in effect each year thereafter.

3. Student Progression Plan. This policy will be included as an addendum to the Student Progression Plan.
